Little Flower School is a Christian Educational Institution run by the Congregation of the Missionary Sisters of Mary Help Of Christians (MSMHC) The congregation of The Missionary Sisters of Mary Help of Christians was founded in 1942 by Arch Bishop Stephen Ferrando in Assam. The main charism of the congregation is Missionary Evangelization and Education of youth. We follow the educational method of St. John Bosco, the great educator of youth, called The Preventive System. This method is based on the Love of God, on conviction, prevention of faults by proper assistance and supervision, and friendly correction.

#### ADMISSION TO SCHOOL

The school admits boys and girls to classes Pre-KG to XII, irrespective of any caste, creed or religion.

Pre-KG is the initial class in the school. No interview based on any knowledge is required for a child while seeking admission Pre-Kg and LKG. To be admitted, a child must have completed three years on1st June of the current year.

The decision with regard to admission rests with the Principal. Admissions to other classes will depend on the performance of the students in the entrance test and interview by the school.

Interview of the parents/guardians will be conducted to assess their degree of compliance to the rules, methods and functioning of the school.

The following documents should be produced at the time of admission:

- The Photostat copy of the original birth certificate and two passport size photographs of the child.
- b) Photocopy of the Aadhar Card.
- c) (For those who seek admission in higher classes) Original Transfer certificate from the school last attended, Conduct certificate from the Head of the School, two photographs, and Progress Report from the school.

The parent/guardian must sign the admission form personally assuming responsibility for his/her child's regularity in School, his/her conduct, discipline, punctuality and payment of fees.

#### **TEACHING DYNAMICS**

Class room teaching, Smart Class based teaching, Workshops, Seminars, Assignments, Projects, Training sessions for soft skills are the methods used in the school.

Attendance and participation in all the classes and activities are mandatory for a student to be eligible for appearing in examinations at the end of each term.

#### **EXAMINATION AND PROMOTION**

- The school conducts the tests and examinations periodically.
   The entire academic period of the year is divided into three periodic assessments and two Mid-Term examinations.
- 2. For the Final Examinations, the whole syllabus willbe included.
- Besides the formative and summative assessments, the school conducts weekly tests and revision examinations. Weekly test is conducted on every Monday, usually termed as Monday Test.
- 4. Promotion shall be made to the next higher class on the basis of pupil's total performance as assessed by periodic tests and final examination. It is therefore very essential that students appear in all the examinations. The minimum marks required for promotion is 40% in each subject. At the Senior Secondary Level, a minimum of 45% marks in each subject in the Annual Examination and a total of 50% in all subjects in the first and second terminal examinations taken together will mark a student eligible for promotion to class XII.
- 5. Pupils who absent themselves from examinations except for a grave reason, will be considered to have failed in the examination concerned.

- Besides the academic performance, each student's performance in co-scholastic areas and activities, attitudes and values, Health and Physical Education will be assessed and grade points will be marked in the Progress Report.
- 7. Parents/guardians come to the school on the day and date allotted for meeting the teacher to discuss the student's performance and to sign the Progress Report Cards.
- 8. No re-examination will be conducted in any subject. The results once declared are final and will not be reconsidered.
- 9. Perfect order and discipline should be maintained during examinations.

#### CLASSES LKG & UKG

BOYS: White striped shirt with short sleeves and the school emblem on the pocket of the shirt, blue black short pants with School Belt, black shoes and royal blue socks.

GIRLS: White striped shirt with short sleeves and the school emblem on the pocket of the shirt, blue black frock, black shoes and royal blue socks, and white ribbon.

#### **CLASSES I TO IV BOYS:**

White striped shirt with short sleeves and the school emblem on the pocket of the shirt, blue black short pants with school belt, black shoes and royal blue socks.

#### **CLASSES V TO XII BOYS:**

White striped shirt with short sleeves and the school emblem on the pocket of the shirt, blue black pants with school belt, black shoes and royal blue socks.

#### ITO V GIRLS:

White striped shirt with short sleeves and the school emblem on the pocket of the shirt, blue black pleated skirt reaching below the knee, black shoes and royal blue socks, white ribbon.

#### P.T UNIFORM ON WEDNESDAY

#### DISCIPLINARY REGULATIONS FOR THE STUDENTS:

- 1. Every student is required to purchase and read the school diary which must be brought daily to school.
- Orderliness in the classrooms and in the school compound is to be maintained by all. The student should not bring to school any object which would prove a source of distraction.
- The medium of instruction and the language for communication in the school is English. Everyone is expected to speak English in the school. Students who are speaking other languages will be subjected to corrective measures.
- 4. Permission of the Principal is required:
- a. to leave the school during school hours.
- b. to collect money for any purpose.
- c. to form associations or to distribute literature of any kind.
- 5. Students must show respect and reverence to the Principal, Sisters, Teachers, Non-teaching staff, Elders etc. and towards each other.
- 6. Irregular attendance, habitual idleness, disobedience, will bring a dismissal at any time of the year unless a child after having been admonished, corrects his/her faults.
- 7. Any damage done to the school property must be made good by the concerned students.
- 8. Ornaments of any metal/material, fancy watches etc. should not be worn by the students.
- 9. Students are not allowed to enter other classes.
- The school is not responsible for any goods or money lost by the pupils. It is not advisable to bring any valuable articles esp. gold to the school.
- 11. Personal hygiene and cleanliness is expected from every child.
- 12. Students should cooperate with the school authority in caring for the School property and for cleanliness of the school premises.

- 13. Pupils are responsible for their good conduct in School and also for their general behavior outside. Any report of objectionable conduct on the part of any pupil will make him/her liable for disciplinary action. Misbehaviour in public places and conveyances is liable to invite the similar action.
- 14. The Principal, in the interest of the school may ask a parent /guardian to withdraw his child/ward, should the child's conduct, behaviour or influence, in the principals opinion, be in any way detrimental to the common good of the school and its smooth working.
- 15. All students are required to wear the School uniform. Neatness in dress and person should be cultivated by every student.
- Every student is expected to carry packed lunch from home. No student will be allowed to leave the school premises during the lunch break.
- 17. Pupils who fail two years consecutively may be asked to leave the school.
- 18. Books, newspapers or magazines other than those needed for class work should not be brought to the school without permission from the Principal.
- 19. Any student suffering from an infectious or contagious disease should refrain from attending school till recovery.
- 20. Exchange of articles or money transactions between pupils is not allowed
- 21. No pupil of the school is allowed to take part in political activities or join organizations sponsored by political parties.
- 22. Once the children report to School they must not leave the school premises without the permission of the Principal. The School will not be responsible for the safety of offenders in this respect.
- 23. The School cannot be held responsible for accidents (minor or serious) to pupils during their stay in School or while taking part in sports and other activities within or outside the School premises. It is assured that the school takes utmost care for the well being of the students.

#### ABSENCE AND LEAVE

- Leave of absence on a regular class may be granted for a sufficient cause, but only on a written request from the parents or guardian.
   Any request for leave must be made to the Principal in writing. Verbal request will not be complied with.
- 2. If a pupil is absent due to illness or any other cause, the principal should be informed about it.
- 3. Leave of absence on medical ground must be supported by medical certificate and leave application.
- 4. Pupils who are absent for more than 10 of the working days of the school without proper authorization shall not be allowed to present themselves for the promotion examination

# LIBRARY RULES

- 1. Perfect silence and order must be maintained while going and coming to, and inside the library.
- 2. All the students of stds.VI to XII may borrow books from the school library. Students of Std. I to V have their own class libraries.
- 3. Students may choose their books from the shelves. They must take the books to the librarian for checking.
- 4. Exchange of library books is not permitted.
- Books may be kept for one week and must be returned by the due date on the date-slip. If need be, renewal for a second week may be granted.
- 6. Students who keep books longer than the time permitted will pay Rs.1 fine a day.
- 7. If any book is lost or damaged by any student it has to be replaced.
- 8. Issue and return of library books will be done during the library period allotted to each class.
- 9. Books in the reference section may not be taken out of the library.
- Never disfigure a library book or damage it in any way. The attention
  of the librarian should be drawn to the damage of books at the time
  of borrowing.

#### **FEE REGULATIONS:**

- The school is unaided in nature and collects fees from the students. It comprises of Tuition Fees, Smart Class Fees, Computer Lab Fees and Fees for Soft skills (Activities). The Fees structure is revised at periodic intervals, usually after two years.
- Fees will be received in four terms of three months each, in the bank. The pay slips will be issued to each child by which the guardians can deposit the amount in the bank account of the school.
- 3. The Fees for the whole year (four terms) should be cleared before the final examinations.
- 4. Pupils whose dues are not cleared completely will be barred from sitting for examinations.
- 5. No Transfer Certificate will be issued unless fees have been paid up to date.
- 6. Promotion of those who have not cleared all the dues will be withheld.

#### **HOUSE SYSTEM**

"Together Each one Achieves More" (TEAM).

The school activities are planned in such a way that the students work, perform and learn in a team. Working in a team, the students are encouraged to unravel their talents and abilities and put them to optimum use so that they get every opportunity to bloom to their total capacity. The students are divided in to four groups which may be called houses. Each house has a captain, a vice-captain and teachers as advisors. House wise competitions and contests organized in a healthy atmosphere create a sense of self confidence, and competence in the students. Moreover they get the opportunity to form healthy character, team spirit, loyalty, compassion and commitment, the values that will see them succeed in their future.

Result of all such competitions are graded and added to the grade points under the continuous and comprehensive evaluation of the students in each academic year.

# PARENT - TEACHER ASSOCIATION (P.T.A.)

All parents of the students and teachers of the school are members of the Parent Teacher Association (PTA) of the school. The PTA is expected to meet periodically. The annual subscription of Rs.100/- shall be collected along with the Academic fees at the beginning of the academic year. The aims and objectives of the association are:

- \* To bring better understanding between the parents and teachers who are partners in the education of the children.
- \* To assess the pupil's progress, discipline, health, physical education, obedience to teachers, regularity in doing assignments etc.
- \* To arrange meetings, seminars and cultural programs for improving the relationship among parents, pupils and teachers.
- \* To raise funds for a specific purpose related to school's welfare.
- \* To do any work related to the welfare of the students and the school.

#### RECOMMENDATIONS TO PARENTS

- 1. Parents should go through the school diary daily.
- 2. Parents and teachers should develop a cordial relationship among themselves for the better education of the children. As such we avoid criticisms, but promote a culture of cooperation and mutual help.

- 3. Children should be escorted to and from the school by authorized persons only.
- 4. Parents shall not meet the teachers during class time, without the Principal's permission.
- 5. They should attend the school functions and be co-operative in all the school activities.
- 6. In case of contagious disease, parents are advised to keep the children at home for rest and medication till complete recovery.
- Parents should see that their children are neatly dressed in the prescribed school uniform and they attend school regularly and punctually.
- 8. They are further requested not to take away their wards from the school during the school hours.
- 9. Parents should see that their children study their lessons regularly and do their homework properly.
- 10. Parents who seek information or need clarification on any matters related to their ward may meet the Principal (and not the class teacher).

#### TRANSFER CERTIFICATE

- 1. A guardian who wishes to transfer his/her ward from the school to another for any reason put in a request in the prescribed form.
- 2. If the transfer is desired at the end of the academic year, the application has to be submitted on the date informed by the school.
- 3. The Transfer certificate will be issued after a week of receipt of the application.
- 4. Transfer Certificate will be issued only after the clearance of all the dues. A fee will be charged for the issue of the transfer certificate or it's duplicate.
- 5. Pupils leaving the school in the middle of the term must give a month's notice and a month's fee in lieu thereof.
